

**State Alabama
Pike County**

The Pike County Commission met in a regular session on April 13, 2026, at 5:15 P.M. in the main auditorium of the Pike County Courthouse Annex – Pike County Health Department Building at which time the following members were present: Chairman Chad Copeland, Commissioners Lawanda Green Bell, Robin Sullivan, Jimmy Barron, Cynthia Pearson, and Russell Johnson.

Commissioner Barron made a motion to approve the March 23, 2026, meeting minutes, as presented. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Pearson made a motion to approve the claims, as presented. Commissioner Sullivan seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Sullivan made a motion to approve the renewal for Solid Waste exemptions, as presented. Commissioner Green Bell seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Sullivan made a motion to cancel the next scheduled Commission Meeting on April 27, 2026, due to the County holiday. Commissioner Pearson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Sullivan made a motion to suspend the rules to allow for a vote on approving a contract with EUS Professional Solutions 18, LLC for geotechnical engineering services, approve a Deputy Coroner request, approve a salary adjustment from the Reappraisal Department, and approve to apply for an Alabama Semi quincennial Community Grant in the amount of \$2,500. Commissioner Pearson seconded the motion and the following roll call vote was recorded:

Commission Sullivan made a motion to approve the County Engineer's request to contract with EUS Professional Solutions 18, LLC to perform geotechnical engineering services for an estimated \$11,500 on County Roads 2201, 6648, and 1179. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Sullivan made a motion to appoint Katelyn Hurst as a new Pike County Deputy Coroner, with her pay being made retroactive to March 1, 2026. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commission Johnson made a motion to approve the Revenue Commissioner's request to adjust Chief Appraiser, Jason Ellis, from a Grade P, Step 7 to a Grade P, Step 11, effective April 22, 2026. Commissioner Sullivan seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Sullivan made a motion to approve for the Commission to apply for an Alabama Semi quincennial Community Grant in the amount of \$2,500 to be used in partnership with the Johnson Center for the Arts for community celebrations for the Semi quincennial celebration of Alabama. Commissioner Pearson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Pearson made a motion to approve the County Administrator's request to reject the bid received for the old EMA building located at 216 S. Oak Street Troy, Alabama and to list the building for sale by owner. Commissioner Sullivan seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Johnson made a motion to approve Resolution 2026-0413 to authorize the filing of an application for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Economic Development funds for a proposed project consisting of the construction of approximately 14,800 linear feet of additional 12-inch water main along County Road 7717, creating a hydraulic loop around the Lockheed Martin facility. Commissioner Green Bell seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Johnson made a motion to approve the County Engineer's request to advertise for an Equipment Operator I or II, due to a vacancy in the department. Commissioner Pearson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Sullivan made a motion to approve the County Engineer's request to approve the Family Medical Leave Request for John Johnson at the Pike County Road Department. Commissioner Green Bell seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Johnson made a motion to approve the NASPO ValuePoint participating addendum with Verizon, as presented. Commissioner Sullivan seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Barron made a motion to approve the following items surplus as property and to be sold at auction:
