Pike County

The Pike County Commission met in a regular session on July 12, 2021 at 5:15 P.M. in the main auditorium of the Pike County Courthouse Annex – Pike County Health Department Building at which time the following members were present: Chairman Robin Sullivan, Commissioners Homer Wright, Jimmy Barron, Chad Copeland, Cynthia S. Pearson, and Russell Johnson.

Commissioner Barron made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of June 28, 2021 as presented. Commissioner Pearson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Wright made a motion to approve the claims as presented. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Johnson made a motion to suspend the rules to allow for a vote pay Bentley Turf & Landscape up to \$14,500 for litter control. Commissioner Barron seconded the motion and the following roll call vote was recorded:

Commissioner Johnson made a motion to approve to pay Bentley Turf & Landscape up to \$14,500 for litter control. Commissioner Copeland seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Barron made a motion to approve the County Engineer's request to hire Christopher Scott McKenney as a full-time Operator II at a Grade 5A, Step J and to promote Dillon Turner, effective July 14, 2021, to an Operator II at a Grade 5A, Step J. Commissioner Copeland seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Copeland made a motion to approve the County Engineer's request to reject all bids upon recommendations from the Alabama Department of Transportation and the Federal Highway Administration for the bridge culvert replacement over Buckhorn Branch on County Road 6618 and to proceed with readvertising for sealed bids upon receiving authorization from the FHWA. Commissioner Pearson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Johnson made a motion to approve Resolution 2020-0712B and to accept the bid from Flint Equipment Company in the amount of \$54,000 for the purchase of a used smooth drum vibratory roller, with \$25,000 coming from the budgeted amount for this item and the additional \$29,000 to be financed with BankcorpSouth with a 2.41% rate for a term of two years. Commissioner Copeland seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Copeland made a motion to approve the County Engineer's request to reimburse the Pike County Water Authority for the waterline relocation for the County Road's 7749 and 2256 CDBG Project, with the contingency that the County Administrator and County Engineer decide what funds to use to pay for this expenditure. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Copeland made a motion to approve the County Engineer's request to advertise for the attached annual bids for goods and services, with the addition of an annual bid for Litter Control. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Barron made a motion to cancel the August 23, 2021 Commission Meeting due to the ACCA Conference in Perdido Beach, Alabama. Commissioner Pearson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Johnson made a motion to approve the County Administrator's request to establish county levies for new ABC license types, as attached. Commissioner Copeland seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Barron made a motion to approve Resolution 2021-0712 confirming and ratifying the levy of a countywide sales tax in Pike County. Commissioner Wright seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Barron made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Wright seconded the motion and all voted yea.
