The Pike County Commission met in a regular session on March 24, 2025 at 5:15 P.M. in the main auditorium of the Pike County Courthouse Annex – Pike County Health Department Building at which time the following members were present: Chairman Chad Copeland, Commissioners Lawanda Green-Bell, Robin Sullivan, Jimmy Barron, and Russell Johnson. Commissioner Cynthia Pearson was absent.

Commissioner Barron made a motion to approve the March 10, 2025, meeting minutes, as presented. Commissioner Sullivan seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Sullivan made a motion to approve the claims as presented. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Barron made a motion to approve the County Engineer's request to approve John Johnson leave under the Family Medical Leave Act for approximately two weeks. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Sullivan made a motion to approve the County Engineer's request to award the PCP 55-13-25 Countywide Striping Project to Ozark Striping Company, Inc. for the base bid amount of \$41,920.00 and additive alternate #1 of \$13,545.00, for a total price of \$55,465.00. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Sullivan made a motion to approve the County Engineer's request to re-bid the Right-of-Ways mowing for this year. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Johnson made a motion to approve the County Engineer's request to advertise for bids for the FY2025 Resurfacing Project, with a proposed bid opening date of May 19th. Commissioner Sullivan seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Johnson made a motion to suspend the rules to allow for a vote on approving an 18-month contract with Brightly Software, Inc. for an asset management software system. Commissioner Sullivan seconded the motion and the following roll call vote was recorded:

Commissioner Green-Bell seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Johnson made a motion to approve Ark Remediation, LLC to remove and dispose of asbestos from the former Shellhorn Junior High School building and relocate miscellaneous items and materials to other areas within the building to accommodate abatement for a total price of \$35,780. The Gas Tax fund will pay an estimated \$7,000 from the overage on the sale of the dump trucks, with the remaining balance being paid for by Chairman Copeland and the Country Administrator's choice of funds. Commissioner Sullivan seconded the motion and all voted yea.
