

PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

Pursuant to the *Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act* (the CARES Act) that was passed by Congress and signed into law by President Trump on March 27, 2020, the State of Alabama (the State) has been awarded the amounts of (1) \$14,011,858 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Round 1 funds (CDBG CV-1), (2) \$15,068,316 in CDBG Round 2 funds (CDBG CV-2), and (3) \$11,379,612 in CDBG Round 3 funds (CDBG CV-3), for a total award amount of \$40,459,786 from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). CDBG-CV Program activities must meet the performance goals of preventing, preparing for, and responding to the spread of infectious diseases such as COVID-19.

The Pike County Commission received \$614,693 from the CDBG-CV Program to purchase two ambulances and associated equipment for the purpose of preventing, preparing for, and responding to the spread of infectious diseases such as COVID-19. A **public hearing** will be held at **5:15 p.m. on Monday, February 12, 2024**, in the Commission Chambers for the purpose of obtaining all citizens' input on the performance of local officials, city staff, administrators, engineers, and contractors on the actual use of CDBG-CV funds during the implementation of a CDBG-CV program. Citizens will also be requested to assess the performance of the Commission in resolving identified community development and housing needs, and in achieving its community development goals and objectives.
