The Pike County Commission met in a regular session on July 11, 2022, at 5:15 P.M. in the main auditorium of the Pike County Courthouse Annex – Pike County Health Department Building at which time the following members were present: Chairman Robin Sullivan, Commissioners Homer Wright, Jimmy Barron, Chad Copeland, Cynthia S. Pearson, and Russell Johnson.

Commissioner Barron made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of June 27, 2022, as presented. Commissioner Wright seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Wright made a motion to approve the claims as presented. Commissioner Pearson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Copeland made a motion to adopt Resolution 2022-0711A which decreases the speed limit on County Road 2256 to thirty-five miles per hour (35 MPH). Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Barron made a motion to suspend the rules to allow for a vote to approve the purchase of nine (9) storage units for the Sheriff's Office vehicles in the amount of \$1,520.00 each from Sci-2-Way. Commissioner Pearson seconded the motion and the following roll call vote was recorded:

Commissioner Barron made a motion to approve the purchase of nine (9) storage units for the Sheriff's Office vehicles in the amount of \$1,520.00 each from Sci-2-Way. Commissioner Pearson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Copeland made a motion to approve the County Administrator's request to send out RFP's for an ambulance bid on the CDBG-CV Grant CV-NC-20-030. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Johnson made a motion to approve the County Administrator's request to establish the new ABC license types, Hospitality Management Program License and Food or Beverage Truck License, at the same rate as the state license fee. Commissioner Copeland seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Pearson made a motion to adopt Resolution 2022-0711B authorizing Pike County to join the State of Alabama and other local governments as participants in current and future opioid settlements and to allow the Chairman to execute the Settlement Sign-On Agreements and any other formal agreement and related documents related to the Opioid Epidemic. Commissioner Wright seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Johnson made a motion to set the fiscal year 2022-2023 budget hearings on August 8, 2022, at 3:00PM in the Commission Chambers at the Health Department. Commissioner Pearson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Johnson made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Pearson seconded the motion and all voted yea.
