The Pike County Commission met in a regular session on November 24, 2025 at 5:15 P.M. in the main auditorium of the Pike County Courthouse Annex – Pike County Health Department Building at which time the following members were present: Chairman Chad Copeland, Commissioners Lawanda Green Bell, Robin Sullivan, Jimmy Barron, Cynthia Pearson, and Russell Johnson.

Commissioner Barron made a motion to approve the November 10, 2025 meeting minutes, as presented. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Pearson made a motion to approve the claims, as presented. Commissioner Sullivan seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Sullivan made a motion to approve the Solid Waste exemptions, as presented, to approve one new exemption and renew 8 exemptions. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Johnson made a motion to approve a new postage machine lease for the Courthouse with Pitney Bowes, at a rate of \$1,404.45 per quarter. Commissioner Sullivan seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Johnson made a motion to approve the highest-scoring RFQ respondent, the Association of County Commissions of Alabama (ACCA), for the provision of grant writing and

grant administration services, specifically to prepare two grant applications for Lockheed Martin. Commissioner Green Bell seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Barron made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Sullivan seconded the motion and all voted yea.
