The Pike County Commission met in a regular session on June 8, 2026, at 5:15 P.M. in the main auditorium of the Pike County Courthouse Annex – Pike County Health Department Building at which time the following members were present: Chairman Chad Copeland, Commissioners Lawanda Green Bell, Robin Sullivan, Jimmy Barron, Cynthia Pearson, and Russell Johnson.

Commissioner Barron made a motion to approve the May 11, 2026, meeting minutes, as presented. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Sullivan made a motion to approve the claims, as presented. Commissioner Pearson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Sullivan made a motion to approve the Solid Waste exemption, as presented. Commissioner Green Bell seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Sullivan made a motion to suspend the rules to allow for a vote on approving the County Engineer’s request to upgrade the fuel system at the Road Department, with funding for the project to be approved by the County Administrator. Commissioner Johnson made a motion to approve Resolution 2026-0608 authorizing the filing of an application for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) administrated by the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs (ADECA). Commissioner Sullivan seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Sullivan made a motion to appoint Commissioner Russell Johnson to the 2026-2027 ACCA Legislative Committee. Commissioner Pearson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Pearson made a motion to approve Resolution 2026-0608A updating the travel policy for county officials and employees. Commissioner Green Bell seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Barron made a motion to approve the Revenue Commissioner's request to hire Breanna Copeland as a Revenue Customer Service Representative I at a Grade B, Step 2, due to her previous experience. Commissioner Sullivan seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Johnson made a motion to approve the Memorandum of Understanding between the Alabama Department of Public Health and the Pike County Coroner's office for the mortuary cooler. Commissioner Sullivan seconded the motion and all voted yea.
