The Pike County Commission met in a regular session on February 9, 2026, at 5:15 P.M. in the main auditorium of the Pike County Courthouse Annex – Pike County Health Department Building at which time the following members were present: Chairman Chad Copeland, Commissioners Lawanda Green Bell, Robin Sullivan, Jimmy Barron, Cynthia Pearson, and Russell Johnson.

Commissioner Barron made a motion to approve the January 26, 2026, meeting minutes, as presented. Commissioner Pearson seconded the motion and all voted yea.
