Position: Maintenance Supervisor

Description: Supervises custodial personnel in the maintenance of the County's buildings and grounds areas, including performing minor electrical, plumbing, and structural repairs as needed; performs directly related work as required. The principal function of an employee in this class is to supervise custodial personnel in the maintenance of the County's buildings and grounds. The work is performed under the direction and supervision of the Facilities Manager, but considerable leeway is granted for the exercise of independent judgement and initiative. The nature of the work performed requires that an employee in this class establish and maintain effective working relationships with the Facilities Manager, County Administrator, custodial personnel, other County employees, and the general public. The principal duties of this class are performed in a variety of County facilities and grounds areas.
