The Pike County Commission met in a regular session on July 13, 2026, at 5:15 P.M. in the main auditorium of the Pike County Courthouse Annex – Pike County Health Department Building at which time the following members were present: Chairman Chad Copeland, Commissioners Lawanda Green Bell, Robin Sullivan, Jimmy Barron, Cynthia Pearson, and Russell Johnson.

Commissioner Barron made a motion to approve the June 22, 2026, meeting minutes, as presented. Commissioner Pearson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Sullivan made a motion to approve the claims, as presented. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Sullivan made a motion to suspend the rules to consider approval authorizing the Chairman, County Administrator, and County Engineer to proceed with the purchase of two new 2026 model trucks from Nextran Truck Centers, provided the purchase complies with all applicable procurement laws, whether through an authorized purchasing method or the competitive bid process. Commissioner Sullivan made a motion to approve authorizing the Chairman, County Administrator, and County Engineer to proceed with the purchase of two new 2026 model trucks from Nextran Truck Centers, provided the purchase complies with all applicable procurement laws, whether through an authorized purchasing method or the competitive bid process. Commission Johnson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Barron made a motion to award the bids for County Roads 2201, 2228, 3346, and 6648 of the FY2026 County Transportation Plan to Chilton Contractors, Inc. in the amount of \$1,303,177.28. Commissioner Pearson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Johnson made a motion to approve the County Engineer's request to award Wiregrass Construction Company, Inc. the contract for annual hot asphalt plant mix for FY 2027. Commissioner Sullivan seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Sullivan made a motion to approve the County Engineer's request to reject the annal bituminous surface treatment bid and allow the County Engineer to negotiate future projects involving this treatment for the 2027 fiscal year. Commissioner Green Bell seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Barron made a motion to approve the County Engineer's request to promote Kyle Goodson to the Assistant County Engineer as an exempt employee at a Grade O, Step 6, effective July 15, 2026. Commissioner Sullivan seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Sullivan made a motion to surplus a utility trailer, VIN# 1TTLH610591505714, in the Sheriff's Department. Commissioner Green Bell seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Johnson made a motion to approve the Facilities Manager's request to hire Heather Brown as a Custodian at a Grade B, Step 14. Commissioner Sullivan seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Barron made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Sullivan seconded the motion and all voted yea.
