The Pike County Commission met in a regular session on September 27, 2021 at 5:15 P.M. in the main auditorium of the Pike County Courthouse Annex – Pike County Health Department Building at which time the following members were present: Chairman Robin Sullivan, Commissioners Homer Wright, Jimmy Barron, Chad Copeland, Cynthia S. Pearson, and Russell Johnson.

Commissioner Barron made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of September 13, 2021, as presented. Commissioner Wright seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Johnson made a motion to approve the claims as presented. Commissioner Copeland seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Johnson made a motion to accept the County Engineer's request to approve the completion of probation and classification of county employee, Dan Zapata, as a full-time Operator II and county employee, Travis Jacques, as a full-time Engineering Aide II. Commissioner Copeland seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Wright made a motion to approve the County Administrator's request to approve the 2021-2022 fiscal year budget and holiday schedule, as presented in the agenda package, to include a 3% Anniversary raise for employees and Elected Officials. Commissioner Barron seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Barron made a motion to approve a new lease agreement with George W. Gilmore, III to rent the Juvenile Probation building for \$1,500 per month beginning October 1, 2021. Commissioner Wright seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Pearson made a motion to approve the County Administrator's request to approve the annual Juvenile Detention contracts as presented. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Copeland made a motion to adopt Resolution No. 2021-0927 and approve a Digital Information Cooperative Agreement with the Alabama Department of Transportation for a grant amount of \$10,000, with a 20% match from Pike County. Commissioner Pearson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Copeland made a motion to accept a reciprocal agreement with the State of Alabama Department of Revenue for exchange of tax information. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Wright made a motion to adopt Resolution No. 21-0927A to change the District 1, Precinct 2 polling place from the Meeksville Volunteer Fire Department located at 2669 County Road 7714 Troy, Alabama 36081 to the Meeksville Storm Shelter located at 1432 County Road 7714 Troy, Alabama 36081. Commissioner Barron seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Johnson made a motion to cancel the next scheduled Commission Meeting on October 11, 2021, due to the Columbus Day holiday. Commissioner Pearson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Barron made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Wright seconded the motion and all voted yea.
