The Pike County Commission met in a regular session on February 24, 2025 at 5:15 P.M. in the main auditorium of the Pike County Courthouse Annex – Pike County Health Department Building at which time the following members were present: Chairman Chad Copeland, Commissioners Lawanda Green-Bell, Robin Sullivan, Jimmy Barron, Cynthia S. Pearson, and Russell Johnson.

Commissioner Barron made a motion to approve the February 10, 2025, meeting minutes, as presented. Commissioner Pearson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Sullivan made a motion to approve the claims as presented. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Barron made a motion to approve Option 2C of the County Engineer’s request to sell two Motor Graders and purchase three Motor Graders, in return, for a purchase amount of \$999,171, with a down payment of \$265,000, with \$215,000 of the down payment to be paid out of the Lodging Tax Fund and \$50,000 to be paid out of the Gas Tax Fund. Commissioner Pearson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Sullivan made a motion to surplus two tri-axle dump trucks at the JM Wood Auction and to surplus the 1987 mechanic’s truck (#87-02) through Gov Deals. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Pearson made a motion to approve the County Engineer’s request to advertise for bids for the FY2025 Traffic Striping Project. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Johnson made a motion to suspend the rules to allow for a vote on approving the Brendle Sprinkler contract, two E911 Board Appointments, and the completion of probation and classification of county employee, Brittany Arnold. Commissioner Sullivan seconded the motion and the following roll call vote was recorded:

Commissioner Johnson made a motion to approve the County Administrator’s request to approve a contract with Brendle Sprinkler Company Inc. to perform annual, quarterly, and semi-annual inspections at the Judicial Building, Pike County Jail, Logistics Building, and 911 EMA Facility, in the amount of \$6,275.00 annually. Commissioner Pearson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Johnson made a motion to reappoint Cory Rushing and Sheriff Russell Thomas to the Pike County Communications District Board for a four-year term ending December 31, 2028. Commissioner Pearson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Sullivan made a motion to approve the Probate Judge's request to approve the completion of probation and classification of county employee, Brittany Arnold. Commissioner Barron seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Barron made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Sullivan seconded the motion and all voted yea.
