The Pike County Commission met in a regular session on May 11, 2026, at 5:15 P.M. in the main auditorium of the Pike County Courthouse Annex – Pike County Health Department Building at which time the following members were present: Chairman Chad Copeland, Commissioners Lawanda Green Bell, Robin Sullivan, Jimmy Barron, Cynthia Pearson, and Russell Johnson.

Commissioner Barron made a motion to approve the April 13, 2026, meeting minutes, as presented. Commissioner Pearson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Sullivan made a motion to approve the claims, as presented. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Pearson made a motion to approve the renewal for Solid Waste exemption, as presented. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Pearson made a motion to approve the County Engineer’s request to advertise for bids on County Road 2201 FDR/Resurface, County Road 2228 Resurface, County Road 3346 Resurface, and County Road 6648 FDR/Resurface for the FY2026 Transportation Plan project. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Sullivan made a motion to approve the County Engineer’s request to advertise for annual bids for Hot Mix Asphalt and Bituminous Surface Treatment. Commission Green Bell seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Sullivan made a motion to suspend the rules to allow for a vote on approving a bill for the Volunteer Fire Association in the amount of \$1,664.60 to be paid out of Tobacco Tax, a Trane BAS Maintenance Service Agreement, and the advertising of a Revenue Customer Service Representative I in the Revenue Commission office. Commissioner Sullivan made a motion to approve the advertisement of a Revenue Customer Service Representative I in the Revenue Commission office. Commissioner Green Bell seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Sullivan made a motion to approve the acceptance of a \$2,500 Semi-quincentennial Community Grant. Commissioner Barron seconded the motion and all voted yea.

Commissioner Sullivan made a motion to cancel the next scheduled Commission Meeting on May 25, 2026, due to the Memorial Day holiday. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion and all voted yea.
